The **Shift Supervisor** is responsible for the behavioral management of the resident adolescent girls who are engaged in high-risk behaviors, as well as the implementation of the relational model in daily living, and ensuring the safety and supervision of the residents. The Shift Supervisor is also responsible for ensuring that all STAR Home policies and procedures are adhered to at all times.

Duties include overseeing the overall daily operations of the home and for overseeing the Youth Workers. Review and supervision of daily activity schedules, maintain routines of the residents, supervision of chores and other tasks, engaging residents in positive peer interactions, and daily shift documentation. Also responsible for monitoring interactions between staff and residents, assisting in crisis management, and communicating effectively with co-workers, and reporting to the Program Director daily.

This position works a second shift schedule, and includes some weekend hours.

Qualifications: Bachelor's Degree in Human Services or related field, and at least two years of experience with at-risk youth. Must also hold a valid driver's license, and be able to obtain DCF Med Certification, as well as TCI Certification. Overall skills required include ability to establish a positive rapport with the girls, ability to set professional boundaries and limits, and ability to communicate well with co-workers and internalize supervision.
