This is our answer when asked how the Bridge is responding to current economic and social change. We have been asked this question several times a year for as long as we can remember, and our answer always offers assurance.

Children and families are the center of our work. This is the first sentence of our Core Beliefs statement and our touchstone for the work we do. Furthermore, we do not give up easily. We work hard to find a way. We make it happen. This focus is embedded in our culture and will continue for generations to come.

Many have come before us and many will come after us to carry on the Bridge’s deep commitment to the people we serve. One of our founders, George C. Hastings, passed away this year. George was the voice for people who did not have one and was a grassroots believer in people. He was a man of courage and vision. Our mission to foster the courage and strength in children and families to meet life’s challenges and build fulfilling lives is rooted in the history of the Bridge and people like George who inspire our work.

The Bridge continues to grow and respond to the needs of the communities we serve. Over the years, we have expanded our mental health services to include three clinics, with plans to add more eventually. We have added adult mental health counseling to our array of services, and our Family Resource Center now includes

before- and after-school care to support working parents. And through two federal grants, we now provide emergency shelter, counseling, life skills instruction and housing support to youth not involved in the state system of care.

A source of pride for us is that the Bridge, once again, received a resounding endorsement of our work from the Hartford Foundation for Public Giving. After a rigorous process that included reviews of our governance, fiscal, and program health, the Bridge was awarded a three-year, \$300,000 (\$100,000 per year) operating support grant, our second such grant from the Hartford Foundation.

On behalf of all those coming to the Bridge needing a safe haven, a listening ear, support and care, THANK YOU for keeping the Bridge strong. We continue to count on your generosity so that we can *always* say we are here to stay.

Expanding Support for Families

Our nationally recognized Family Resource Center expands its reach thanks to donor support and new space.

Our guidelines require that we provide or collaborate to provide:

- Early Childhood Education
- School Age Programs
- Family and Parenting Education
- Positive Youth Development
- Training and Support for Family
- Child Care Providers
- Adult Education
- Resource and Referral

From partnering with West Hartford Adult Education to support the needs of Syrian refugee families, to one-on-one parent support, our Family Resource Center (FRC) works hard to help families thrive.

Our FRC has always had a far reach in the community, but when the Town of West Hartford and the West Hartford Public Schools granted it a prime space in the newly constructed Charter Oak International Academy, our ability to serve the community grew exponentially.

"For 26 years, we operated out of the available space in the basement level of the old school, and that was fine," remembers Deborah Zipkin, Director of the Family Resource Center, "but this space is beyond our wildest dreams. It's bright, has a community room for our parenting classes, storage space, and even its own entrance and adjoining playground. Families can see us and have easy access. It has allowed us to serve more children and families, and we are grateful."

For those who don't know, a Family Resource Center receives state funds to serve key areas (see panel to the left). How they do that work in each Center varies.

Our donors and private funders should know that it's their additional support that allows our work to expand beyond the basics and dig deep to serve. Without those additional funds, we simply couldn't work as broadly.




