# Finding a Way

A year in the life of a global pandemic – not anything any one of us ever imagined! It was a year filled with uncertainty, fear, and disruption. Yet, innovation, perseverance, and determination also dominated our days, weeks, and months. These are the silver linings of the pandemic that enabled us to meet the ever-evolving needs of our children and families.

As we adjusted to social distancing, new work environments, and a multitude of changes in our daily lives, one constant remained – our commitment to our children and families. It is the touchstone that guided our work and directed our actions. Our core beliefs were reaffirmed each time we found ourselves wavering or overwhelmed by the logistical and emotional hurdles we faced.



The best interests of the children and families we serve guide every aspect of our work. We put forth our very best effort in all that we do. We are committed to quality, integrity, and a holistic approach to care in a welcoming, nurturing environment. We do not give up easily. We work hard to find a way. We make it happen.

Finding a way meant staying connected to our children and families. Our work is driven through personal interactions. When social distancing hindered our ability to be together, we adopted new practices, implemented new procedures, and ensured we were here for those who needed us the most.

Finding a way meant Circle Time over a screen for our little ones and their caregivers, counseling sessions quickly moving from in-person appointments to Telehealth, and virtual visits with our Independent Living Programs clients. We found a way through FaceTime with children who used our school-based counseling services, Zoom groups with Teen Center participants, and karaoke contests and game nights with the young men and women in our shelters.

We were able to find a way because of you. Our donors, community leaders, and advocates responded generously, compassionately, and with a strong conviction that our programs and services are vital to the health and wellbeing of our children and families. Your support provides hope, comfort, and security at a time when so many of us are struggling with great uncertainty.

### Supporting Children & Families Through a Pandemic

The pandemic has impacted the way our children and families live, learn, work, and connect. While all of the disruptions to daily living have been challenging, the feeling of isolation has been especially difficult. We knew from the onset of the pandemic that remaining in close contact and creating virtual opportunities would be vital to the mental and physical well-being of our children and families. Following are just a few of the innovative and creative ways we met this need:



Counseling Centers - Within a week of the local outbreak of the virus, we quickly and efficiently shifted our counseling sessions from in-person appointments to "meeting" through Telehealth using a variety of technologies including smart phones, iPads, or computers. As the weeks and months wore on, we began to see more and more children, adults, teens, and families in desperate need of our therapy services. Being able to offer Telehealth provided a lifeline to those who were struggling with acute issues of anxiety, depression, and a number of other mental health issues.

### Family Resource Centers -

Our Family Resource Center, located within the Charter Oak International Academy, closed when the West Hartford schools closed. However, we remained in touch with our little ones and their families through phone calls, e-mails, and social media. Virtual play groups and story time created a sense of togetherness and socialization. Engaging toddlers through a computer screen was an interesting and, at times, a challenging experience. When the weather improved, we moved these activities to outside adventures in local parks. In addition to providing support through personal touchpoints, the FRC helped many families by distributing gift cards to cover basic needs and daily living expenses.



#### School Counseling & Teen Center

Although we were unable to meet with our kids at their schools, we remain connected with children and teens in our counseling and mentoring services through Telehealth platforms. Not going to school, changes in sleeping patterns, little to no interaction with friends or in extracurricular activies negatively impacted many children and teenagers. Since these children are especially vulnerable, frequent check-ins to monitor emotions and behaviors were essential. Similarly, we were in regular contact with Teen Center attendees and offered video games, a fitness challenge, and a book club through virtual groups. With the arrival of warmer weather, our Teen Center attendees headed outside for basketball and soccer games, hikes, and field trips.





Residential and Independent Living Programs - All of our shelters remained open throughout the pandemic with best practices to mitigate the spread of the virus in place. Just like in your families, our kids experienced feelings of isolation and staff creatively engaged them in safe, socially-distanced movie nights and karaoke contests. Through phone calls, texts, face time, and even playing virtual video games, caseworkers met with their clients in our Independent Living Programs to evaluate each individual's response to the crisis and provide support as necessary.

# Emergency Family Fund - Knowing our families would need financial help throughout

the pandemic, we created a special Emergency Family Fund to help purchase grocery store or credit card gift cards to assist with buying food, paying bills and covering other living expenses. The fund was generously supported through several individual donations, a Food Drive conducted by Connecticut Wealth Management, and Doug Hoskins' triathlon fundraiser.






