WEST HARTFORD EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION PROGRAMS

We hope that this handout will assist you in investigating early childhood education programs. A listing of all programs in West Hartford is provided on the back of this handout. Below is some general information about the types of programs you will find. West Hartford Public School (WHPS) Pre-K Programs

WHPS has seven pre-k classes at three elementary schools. Eligibility is based on neighborhood; selection is based on lottery. You can apply to more than one school. Applications are due March 15, 2017. Tuition is determined based on household income (maximum for 2016-17: \$4,073). West Hartford Public School (WHPS) Early Learning Centers

WHPS's Early Learning Centers offer reverse inclusion preschool programs designed to provide opportunities for students with and without special needs to learn and grow together. Selection is based on evaluation or lottery. Applications for peer models are due Nov. 30, 2016. Tuition for peer models is \$750 for the year. West Hartford Public School (WHPS) High School Programs

WHPS high school students work with children enrolled in the high school programs under the supervision of their Child Development teachers. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis. Hours and tuition are minimal.

West Hartford Independent Preschools

West Hartford has many independent preschool programs. Each school has its own selection process. Many of the independent schools accept applications on a rolling basis beginning in the Fall of the academic year prior to enrollment.

Regional School Choice (RSC) Programs

West Hartford residents are eligible for a number of magnet schools in the Greater Hartford area under the Regional School Choice Program. Selection is based on lottery. Applications are due Feb. 28, 2017. For more information: www.choiceeducation.org/elementary-schools.

Family Day Care Providers

West Hartford has a number of licensed family day care providers. Please see Great by 8's Family Day Care handout for more details.




Financial Assistance

State School Readiness funds are available for preschool education at public and independent schools on a limited basis for families who qualify. For more information, call 860-929-5552. Preschool Age Eligibility



Consistent with current State law as to kindergarten matriculation, most preschools use a January 1st cut-off date. Thus, a child turning 3 on or prior to January 1st is eligible for a 3 year-old program in September of that year. Please note: RSC programs use a Dec. 31st cut-off date; WHPS Early Learning Centers use a September 1st cut-off date.
